Eligibility Requirements:

- Majoring in Computer Science, Engineering, Math, or their related technologies.
- Full-time student (12+ credit hours) at Glendale Community College.
- A Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.8 or higher.
- Completion of MAT 120 (or higher) with a grade of C or better.
- US Citizen or eligible for Federal Financial Aid.
- You will need to complete a Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA)

Application Materials:

- One Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member (**not for renewal applications**)
- Unofficial Academic Transcripts. Include transcripts from other institutions if relevant course work was done at another institution.
- Complete Glendale Community College Student Scholarship Application (attached).
- Responses to Scholarship Questions (attached).

All application materials must be submitted together, not separately, to the GCC Financial Aid Office. (Attn: Graciela Serrano) Scholarship applications will be reviewed in the order received until all available scholarships have been awarded. Successful candidates, with input from an assigned mentor, will choose four STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Science) events to participate in during the semester.

Amount of Scholarship: Total award of \$2000 per semester.

Applicants who are traditionally underrepresented in Computer Science, Engineering, and Math such as women, students with disabilities, minorities are encouraged to apply.
